

Do you need help managing your child's health care needs?

The Summit Center can help!

At The Summit Center, we know that caring for a child with chronic physical, mental or behavioral health conditions can be complicated and sometimes exhausting. Children's Health Homes is a service that provides a *care manager* – the extra support you need - to help your child's caregivers and providers communicate with each other.

How it works: A Summit Care Manager will work with you side-by-side to ensure that your child has access to needed services and supports to stay healthy, out of the emergency room, and out of the hospital. Services include:

- Help setting health goals and working with you to help your child meet them
- Help coordinating medical appointments, transportation, prescription refills
- 24/7 availability for information and emergency consultation
- Coordinating transition plans between providers
- Individual and Family Support
- Referral to additional community and social support services if needed

Enrollment is free for eligible children.

Eligibility:

- Children (birth to age 21)
- enrolled in Medicaid who have
- **two or more chronic health conditions** (including, but not limited to, Asthma; Obesity; Diabetes; Migraine; and Premature birth)
- or one single qualifying condition (including HIV/AIDS, Serious Emotional Disturbance, and Complex Trauma)
