I go to Expeditions during the school year at Summit! I have so much fun!




Right now, I can't go. Lots of people are getting sick with a virus. Everyone is trying to stay healthy and safe. I must stay healthy and safe, too.












Right now, I don't know when I will go back to expeditions. This makes me feel sad and sometimes mad. That is OK. I can take a break in my room when I feel this way.
