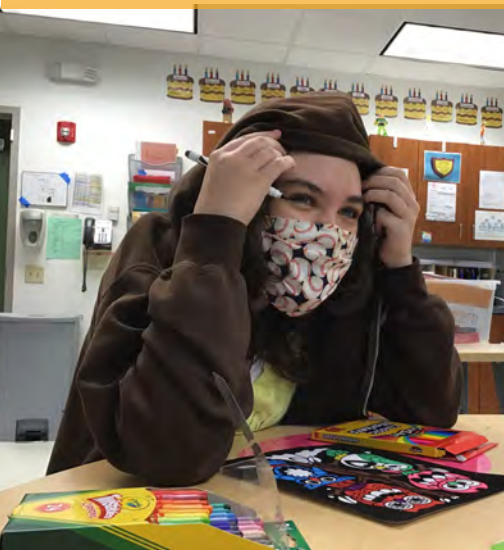
- 1. What will school look like? Health and safety, social distancing, masks and more**
