Dear Summit Families and Caregivers,

I'm writing to provide a quick update on Covid testing prior to our holiday break which begins tomorrow, December 23 – January 3. Much has happened in the past couple days:

- We have received our Limited Service Laboratory (LSL) certificate which allows us to conduct Covid-19 testing at our school.
- We have received a supply of BiNaxNOW rapid tests
- To support our school nurses, we have appointed Unit Director Carol Shaw as our testing coordinator. Working with a team of staff volunteers, Carol will be responsible for scheduling and managing the reporting requirements associated with Covid-19 testing.
- Everyone involved with testing has undergone the necessary training and received additional instruction from our school physician, Dr. Ted Andrews.

We've put together a short video to help familiarize your child with the testing process. We hope you'll share it with your child before they return to school.

As a reminder, if you haven't done so already, we encourage you to return the testing consent form to us. Please print it, sign it, and mail it to us at 150 Stahl Road, Getzville, NY 14068. We will not test any child without parental consent.

Last week we sent a Q&A that will answer many of your questions. If you haven't had a chance, please take a few minutes to review it.

We look forward to seeing our in-person students back in school beginning on Monday, January 4.

Until then, I extend my very best wishes to you and your family for a happy and healthy 2021.
