
What is a "Pivotal Response" in Autism?





PRT: Four Pivotal Areas

Produce widespread, generalized improvements *in (un)targeted behaviors*

PRT: Motivational Procedures

- Point 1: Child Attention
- Point 2: Maintenance Tasks*
- Point 3: Shared Control/Child Choice*

- Point 4: Contingent
- Point 5: Reinforce Attempts*
- Point 6: Direct and Natural Reinforcers*



Child Attention

- The question, instruction, and/or opportunity to respond
 - Child <u>must</u> be attending
 - Should be clear, uninterrupted, and appropriate to the task








Direct and Natural Reinforcers: 2 Keys to PRT
