

COMING IN JULY 2023: ADULT RESPITE @Summit

Beginning in July 2023, The Summit Center will offer a daytime respite program for adults (ages 21 and up) with developmental disabilities who are eligible for OPWDD services.



TIME: Program will operate three days per week (days to be determined) from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. Participants may choose to attend as many days as they like to fit their needs.

LOCATION: Summit's Respite Center at 75 Pineview Dr., Amherst, New York.

STAFFING: 4 – 5 participants to one staff member.

ACTIVITIES: In addition to leisure activities and peer interaction throughout the day, participants will take part in one group community outing per week. Our goal is to provide a positive environment with caring professional staff where participants can interact with peers and enjoy leisure activities during the week.

ELIGIBILITY: Participants must be eligible for OPWDD HCBS Waiver funded programs. Participants should have limited, if any, behavioral support needs and require no medication administered during program hours. They should also require minimal to no assistance with toileting. If interested, please contact us so that we can learn more about you and begin the intake process.

TRANSPORTATION: Participants must provide their own transportation.
